

Hello SWAC -

The volunteer listings for the SWAC invitational on November 15 are now available through our website.

As usual, go to the volunteering page and click on the link for volunteer assignments.

Click yes next to your name/job to accept the position. Please do this by this Wednesday, November 4th so that I can assign jobs to the other SAL teams attending on a timely basis.

Do not contact the reps about invitational volunteering - this is the one meet of the season that I'll ask volunteers to contact me regarding volunteering.

If you indicated during the online registration process for the meet that you could volunteer, you have been assigned a job. We need everyone's help for this meet.

If you have children in both sessions, you have just been assigned to volunteer at one session. If you are available to work at the other session as well, please let me know and I'll put you on as back-up.

If you are able to provide more than one volunteer at a session please let me know that too and I'll also put you down as back-up.

Based on last minute changes and volunteers available from other teams, it is possible that positions may change. This is especially true for timers. Please be flexible and help out where ever needed if you're asked to make a change.

If you do not know what your position requires, review the list on the volunteering page of the website. There are a couple jobs not described there as they are specific to the invitational and/or champs. If you need an explanation ahead of time contact me. Rest assured, however, that I will explain your duties to you on meet day either way.

Another point of clarification, there are not "deck parents" for the invitational. As with other invitationals, our coaches are responsible for getting the SWAC kids to their events. People assigned to ready bench and lane marshal jobs will be organizing all swimmers (from all teams) in a designated area.

Remember to sign-in or sign-out of Saturday's dual meets by the deadline tomorrow (Wednesday, November 4 at 9:00PM).

When signing in for your volunteer responsibility for the invitational (or any meet) remember to scroll down to find the precise meet you want. All dual meets through the end of 2009 and also our invitational (both sessions are listed). Make sure you select the right date and gender for the dual meets. For the invitational make sure you choose the right session (afternoon for swimmers 11 and up or morning for swimmers 10 and under). For the invitational, if your child(ren) is/are swimming you should be on one of the two lists unless you got an email from me noting that you indicated you couldn't work. If you can work and are not on the list, please contact me immediately.
